
**Term:** The term of the nominated members shall be three years.

- Coordinate research, teaching, extension, and other academic activities within the Department and the College.

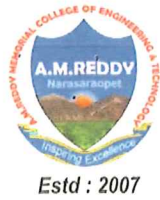

## Agenda

The principal objective of the meeting was the **review and approval of the Civil Engineering theory and laboratory syllabus for the III Year B.Tech, I Semester** under the **AMR-24 Regulations**, aligning accurately with JNTU Kakinada (JNTUK) standards.

## Key Proceedings & Discussions

### 1. Welcome Address

- The BoS Chairman, Dr. K. Sreekar Chand, officially opened the meeting and extended a warm welcome to all panel members, with a special welcome to the JNTUK Nominee, Dr. V. Lakshmi.

## 2. Syllabus Presentation & Credit Allocation

The Chairman presented the detailed course structure for **III Year I Semester (AMR-24 Regulations)**, which carries a total of **23 credits**:

## 3. Deliberations and Expert Feedback

- **Adherence to JNTUK Guidelines:** Dr. Chandrasekhar Rao noted that the syllabus tightly conforms to the guidelines of JNTU Kakinada without deviations.
- **Open Elective Clarification:** In response to an inquiry regarding the Open Elective, the Chairman clarified that Civil Engineering students are opting for **Renewable Energy Resources (RES)** managed by the EEE Department.

Conversely, students from other branches (such as Agriculture Engineering) are taking *Construction Technology and Management* as their Open Elective from Civil Engineering.

- **Introduction of Job-Oriented and Skill Courses:** The panel discussed the future integration of APSCHE and AICTE-mandated job-oriented and skill enhancement electives. The Chairman noted that these concepts are being actively embedded starting from the upcoming **AMR-25 Regulations** (beginning with the current first-year batch) and will fully manifest when they reach their third year.
- **Industry-Relevant Lab Suggestion:** Industry expert input highlighted the critical importance of hands-on software proficiency for placements. A strong recommendation was made to formally incorporate a **BIM (Building Information Modeling) Lab** or dedicated BIM tools into the future practical curriculum to enhance student placement readiness. The Chairman acknowledged the insight and agreed to work toward integrating it in the subsequent semesters (e.g., III-II).

## Resolutions

1. The proposed course structure, theory syllabus, and laboratory frameworks for the III Year I Semester under **AMR-24 Regulations** were unanimously approved by the BoS panel.
2. The valuable recommendations regarding the enhancement of software labs (specifically BIM) and skill-oriented paths were noted for implementation in upcoming academic planning.

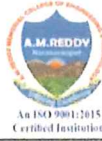
