Purpose

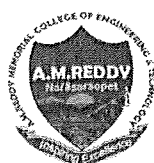

- Foster a culture of inclusivity and equality on campus

- **Educational Empowerment:** Facilitate academic support and resources for SC/ST students to bridge any achievement gaps.
- **Financial Support:** Ensure timely and hassle-free disbursement of government scholarships and financial aids.
- **Grievance Redressal:** Provide a confidential and empathetic forum for resolving issues faced by SC/ST students.
- **Social Inclusion:** Organize events and workshops to promote integration and combat social discrimination.
- **Awareness & Advocacy:** Keep students informed about their rights and the various schemes available to them.
- **Compliance:** Ensure the institution's adherence to all statutory regulations concerning SC/ST welfare.

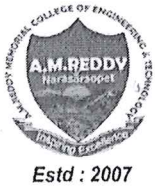
